The San Joaquin Engineers Council is pleased to announce **Nader Shareghi** as the recipient of the distinguished **2011 Distinguished Service Award**.

Nader Shareghi is currently the Public Works Director for the Mountain House Community Services District. He obtained his Bachelors of Science and Masters of Science Degrees in Civil Engineering from California State University Fresno. While a student, Mr. Shareghi worked as a fire fighter during summer vacations, fighting fires in Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks. He joined the California Department of Forestry for several summers as a seasonal fire fighter in the Santa Cruz/ San Mateo County area.

Mr. Shareghi started his full time engineering career in 1986 with the City of Stockton, as a Junior Civil Engineer. He worked in various sections of the Public Works eventually obtaining the position of Senior Civil Engineer in charge of the CIP Design and Project Development as well as Land Development Services in 1991. Mr. Shareghi left the City of Stockton in 2002 to help build the brand new Mountain House Community in Northern California. He is currently the Public Works Director for the Mountain House Community Services District.

Mr. Shareghi's contributions to the engineering profession are extensive. He is an active member of the California Society of Professional Engineers (CSPE), the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE), the American Public Works Association (APWA) and the Construction Institute (CI). He has served as a Board member and president for both ASCE and CSPE, and CSPE Chapter's State Director since 2005. Mr. Shareghi has also served as an active board member, since 1992, of the San Joaquin Engineers Council (SJEC) and has twice served as its chair. Mr. Shareghi stays involved with future generations of engineers by serving as a mentor and professional organization liaison, and by participating in CSPE's Mathcounts competition and the engineering/science competition at San Joaquin Delta College.

Mr. Shareghi is married to Natasha and has three wonderful children. His family is located across the globe and he travels overseas as much as possible to visit them
