Distinguished Service Award Criteria

This award is intended to recognize someone who has shown exceptional dedication and made significant contributions to the engineering profession without expectation of financial reward.

The engineering profession is made up of individuals who apply science to the common purpose of life, and is defined as the “profession in which knowledge of mathematical and natural sciences, gained by study, experience, and practice, is applied with judgment to develop ways to utilize, economically, the materials and forces of nature for the benefit of humankind.” The Engineering Profession truly “Turns Ideas Into Reality”.

**GENERAL CRITERIA**

The recipient must have dedicated their professional knowledge and skills to the advancement of human welfare, participated in none but honest enterprises and lived and worked according to the highest standards of professional conduct; to have placed service before profit, the honor and standing of their profession before personal advantage, and the public welfare above all other considerations.

**SPECIFIC POSSIBLE CRITERIA**

- ⊕ Worked or taught in a profession related to engineering
- ⊕ Considered outstanding in their area of expertise
- ⊕ Served or promoted the advancement of the engineering profession
- ⊕ Civic involvement and volunteerism
- ⊕ Recognition, honors, awards of any type
- ⊕ Positive ethical behavior related to engineering profession experience
- ⊕ Reference letters or acknowledgements of the GENERAL CRITERIA.

**EXAMPLES OF ELIGIBLE NOMINEES**

- ⊕ Employee of agricultural, chemical, civil, computer, electrical, geotechnical, hydrologic, mechanical, transportation engineering firm
- ⊕ Computer science employee who has contributed to the engineering profession
- ⊕ Construction estimator; construction manager; inspector
- ⊕ Teacher, administrator or counselor who has contributed to the engineering profession
